

# Patient Fee Schedule

Nobel Biocare Implantology Year Course 2010-2011

Cavendish House Training Centre

We recognise that many participating dentists will wish to offer their patients financial incentives to take part in the course on a Live Surgery Study Day, where surgical implant treatment is carried out under direct supervision at Cavendish House. This aspect of the course is an essential requirement of the GDC's regulations for training in implant dentistry.

Patients can be charged for their treatment according to one of the four options below. It is entirely the choice of the course participant as to which option he/she wishes to offer their patients. The normal fee charged at Cavendish House for a fully restored single unit implant reflects the UK average of £2,500. The course options available are:-

**Option 1 – Shared Fee Scheme – all treatment at Cavendish House. Total patient's cost is £2,500**

**Surgical implant placement appointment**

Patient pays **£1,300**

Fee split 50:50 with participant after deduction of costs (lab fees, implants etc)

**Impression appointment**

Patient pays **£600**

Fee split 50:50 with participant after deduction of costs (lab fees, implants etc)

**Crown fit appointment**

Patient pays **£600**

Fee split 50:50 with participant after deduction of costs (lab fees, implants etc)

**Option 2 – Shared Fee Scheme – prosthetic stages at participant's own practice. Patient's cost is from £1,900, saving the patient up to £600**

**Surgical implant placement appointment**

Patient pays **£1,300**

Fee split 50:50 with participant after deduction of costs (lab fees, implants etc)

**Impression appointment**

Patient's fee at discretion of treating dentist

**Crown fit appointment**

Patient pays **£600**

This patient fee covers the usual laboratory cost of the crown and abutment

**Option 3 – Discounted Fee Scheme – all treatment at Cavendish House. Total patient’s cost is £1,750, saving the patient £750**

**Surgical implant placement appointment**

Patient pays **£850**

No fee split with participant

**Impression appointment**

Patient pays **£300**

No fee split with participant

**Crown fit appointment**

Patient pays **£600**

This patient fee covers the usual laboratory cost of the crown and abutment

**Option 2 – Discounted Fee Scheme – prosthetic stages at participant’s own practice. Patient’s cost is from £1,450, saving the patient over £1,000**

**Surgical implant placement appointment**

Patient pays **£850**

No fee split with participant

**Impression appointment**

Patient’s fee at discretion of treating dentist

**Crown fit appointment**

Patient pays **£600**

This patient fee covers the usual laboratory cost of the crown and abutment

These fee options allow participating dentists to offer their patients a saving of up to £1,000 over the usual cost of a restored implant. This scheme can help to recruit patients and provide an incentive for patients to travel to the training centre.

\* When the prosthetic stages are carried out at the participant’s own practice this is done with guidance from the participant’s supervisor. At each stage a checklist of treatment is completed by the participant and sent to the supervisor for approval. Upon completion of treatment the artefacts (postoperative casts, photographs, radiographs etc) must be sent to the case supervisor for approval before the case can be signed off. This is a GDC requirement for competency assessment. Practical prosthetic training is provided both on the Year Course Study Days and in an e-training module.

The above fee schemes are only applicable when a patient is treated on a Live Surgery Study Day. They do not apply to appointments outside of the designated course dates when the full normal fee applies, without fee apportionment.

The surgical stage of treatment must always be carried out at the training centre, under direct supervision.
